### As a public Montessori school we:

- Follow the NYS Common Core Learning Standards (CCLS)
- Use Buffalo Public School teaching resources and assessments.
- Integrate a Montessori approach to learning by using lessons from the Montessori curriculum.
- Instill a peaceful community through a <u>peace curriculum</u>, classroom meetings and restorative practices.
- Involve the use of hands-on materials for mastery learning and problem solving. As students get older, there are less materials, but more research and project-based learning.
- Embrace the whole child through **multi-aged classrooms** (3-6), (5-7), (6-9), (9-12), and (12-14).
- Students use work cards to manage choice of work within teacher-set limits, while the teacher works individually or with small groups of students.
- Connect to the natural outdoor environment.
- Provide quarterly Communication Reports, a written form of communication, to share with parents on your child's progress.

### Your Child's First Day of School 2023-2024

Here are a few things to help you and your child prepare for their first day of school: The first day of school, Friday, 9/8 is for all K-8 grade students.

Phasing-In Phasing in is an important tradition at BPMC. It is an opportunity for your child to get comfortable with school, meet new friends, and work with some materials. We realize it may be an inconvenience for the family but the benefits to your child will last all year. We encourage you to make arrangements for your child to attend these important phasing-in days at school.

### 4-YEAR-OLD (PK) PHASING-IN SCHEDULE:

- Tuesday, September 12<sup>th</sup> AM only. Students may take the AM bus to school. Please plan to pick up your child by 12:15pm on this day.
- The first full school day for our 4-year-old students is Wednesday, September 13<sup>th</sup>. PM bussing will begin on September 13<sup>th</sup> for our 4-year-old (PK) students.

### 3-YEAR-OLD (PS) PHASING-IN SCHEDULE:

- Thursday, September 14<sup>th</sup>, Friday, September 15<sup>th</sup> AND Monday, September 18<sup>th</sup> AM only. Students may take the AM bus to school. Please plan to pick up your child by 12:15 pm on these days.
- The first full school day for our 3-year-old (PS) students is *Tuesday, September 18th*. PM bussing will begin on Sept.17th for our 3 year old (PS) students.
- For New students in grades PS 3<sup>rd</sup> (3- to 9-year-olds), please remember to have identification with your child.
- <u>9:10 Arrival -BUS</u>: Students enter the building at 9:10 am using entrance doors on Clinton Street.
- 9:10 Arrival- Walk/Car: Parent drop-off on Cedar Street. A staff member will be stationed at that entrance until 9:30 am to greet your child. Park on surrounding streets. PLEASE DO NOT park on the school side of Clinton Street. There is NO PARKING in the Cedar Street drop-off zone.
- School buses block the staff parking lot on Clinton Street from 8:45 am - 9:45 am, preventing cars from entering or exiting the lot. This lot is again blocked by school busses during dismissal from 3:20pm - 4:30pm. This procedure is in place the entire school year. If you park there, you will be stuck until all buses leave and may be ticketed.
- For the safety of our school community, <u>children walk</u> to their classrooms on their own. Faculty and staff members are visible to greet buses and assist your child with room assignments.

- If you need to change your child's transportation, please email or call. Required - "proof of address".
- Regular Dismissal begins at 3:15 pm for PS, PK & K
  ONLY. 3:30 for 1-3 and 3:40 for 4-8 and students
  with older siblings in 4-8. If you will be picking your
  child up from school, please park on surrounding
  streets or pull up to the Cedar Street door.
- ALL changes in dismissal require school notification. A
  parent signed note is best, and phone calls can be
  accepted before 2:00.
- Early Dismissal (Pick Up before 3:20) This is strongly discouraged. Completing the full school day is important to your child's success.

<u>Supports at Montessori</u> Several resources and supports are available to families and students at Bennett Park Montessori Center. We have a full-time school psychologist, social worker, 2 guidance counselors, and a Say Yes Buffalo family support specialist to assist you and your child as needed. Additionally, Endeavor Health Counseling Service is on-site two days a week to work with students and families.

Free breakfast and lunch All students in BPS receive a free breakfast and lunch. Breakfast and lunch will be available for all students on their first day of school. We take great pride in trying to provide healthy options for your child. Breakfast items include cereals with limited grams of sugar, fresh fruit several days a week, and skim or 1% milk. Options for lunch include: a daily salad through our farm to school grant; a hot lunch with protein, fruit/vegetables, and whole wheat items; or a fun lunch with yogurt and all of the items needed for a balanced nutritional lunch. Bennett Park is a peanut restricted environment. If your child brings lunch to school, please do not include any peanut-based products. We work collaboratively to ensure that students with allergies are in a safe environment. To that end, we do not serve peanut butter in our cafeteria. If your child is a lover of peanut butter, there are several alternatives to peanut butter including sun butter or almond butter.

Immunizations and Student Physicals 23-24: All students will need an updated physical for the required grades in 23-24. The NYS memo that was sent out is listed below.

Doctors' offices will be very busy with all the new appointments We encourage families to get into their primary care provider ASAP.
